

Fire at the Worms site

On Thursday, November 2, 2023, at around 3 p.m., a fire broke out in a Röhm GmbH production plant at the Worms site for as yet unexplained reasons. Some plastic equipment and pipes caught fire. There was heavy smoke development.

Fortunately, there were no injuries. The main fire has been extinguished and the situation is under control. The fire department is still on site.

The authorities have been informed. We will keep you informed about the further course of the incident.
